ULTRAFAST BROADBAND FINALLY ARRIVES IN ACOL!

As of the beginning of July, all Acol homes* are on our new Community Gigabit Fibre Infrastructure, meaning broadband services with speeds approaching 1 gigabit per second (1,000 mb/sec) can be ordered from broadband service providers, although 100+ mb/sec - well over 10x the speeds that have been available in the south of our village - will be perfectly adequate for most households.

We are indebted to villagers who pledged Broadband Gigabit Vouchers enabling the financing of the infrastructure for our whole community. Under the terms of the voucher scheme those households should now place orders for Ultrafast broadband services deliverable via our new network.

Grateful thanks to Karen Ault for her help with the project and for her patience and fortitude when I was at the end of my tether!

COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAMME - 100 K VACCINES!

We are very pleased and proud to announce that Minster Surgery and its PCN Partner Surgeries, have administered 100,000 vaccinations to patients at the Saga Vaccination clinic.

This has contributed to approximately 96% of all venerable people in Thanet being fully vaccinated and 85% of all groups receiving at least one dose of a Covid-19 vaccination.

Vaccination Clinics are continuing to be held at the Saga Centre in Westwood Cross, including Pfizer "walk in" clinics on some Saturdays. Invitations are being sent out to all vulnerable groups, at-risk patients and all those aged 18 and over. Further up to date information can be found on the following website: www.nhs.uk/coronavirus Currently we are receiving supplies of both the Oxford Astra Zenica and Pfizer vaccines, so if you have not yet received your first dose, second Astra Zenica vaccine or may have initially declined the vaccine, Please **BOOK NOW!**

Please note: Once you have had your vaccination you may be asked to sit and wait for 10-15 minutes, depending upon individual circumstances.
