TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Plumstone Road, Monkton will be closed to through traffic, on or after 2nd February 2024 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed between Seamark Road and Minster Road.

The alternative route is via Seamark Road, Crispe Road, B2048 Acol Hill and B2048 The Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 00:00 and 23:59 each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
