**B2050 MANSTON ROAD, ACOL,
BIRCHINGTON**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow tree surgery and overhead telecoms cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2050 Manston Road, Acol, Birchington, in the Thanet area.

Off-peak closures are planned from Monday 10 May 2021 for up to 5 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours each day.

B2050 Manston Road will be closed between the junctions with B2048 Acol Hill and Margate Hill, to the actual extent shown on site.

The main alternative route for through traffic is via B2048 Park Lane, The Square, A28 Canterbury Road, B2052 George V Avenue, Hartsdown Road, Tivoli Road, Beatrice Road (College Road in opposite direction), A254 Ramsgate Road, Margate Road, Pearce Signs Roundabout, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Haine Road back to B2050 Manston Road, and vice versa.

An alternative route, *for light vehicles only*, is via B2048 Acol Hill and Margate Hill

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
