## **A255 RAMSGATE ROAD, BROADSTAIRS**

## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

## **TEMPORARY ORDER 2019**

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A255 Ramsgate Road, Broadstairs.

Overnight closures are planned from Wednesday 6 November 2019 for up to 5 nights, from 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A255 Ramsgate Road will be closed in sections between the junctions with Park Avenue and Yarrow Road, to the extent indicated at any time by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative routes for through traffic (which also apply in reverse directions) are as follows

- For vehicles under 14' 9" only via Queen's Road, A255 High Street (note 14' 9" height limit at Broadstairs Station), The Broadway, St Peter's Road, Broadstairs Road, Fairfield Road, Pysons Road, Allenby Road, B2014 Newington Road, A255 High Street St Lawrence, Park Road, Boundary Road and Hereson Road back to Ramsgate Road
- For any vehicle, via A255 Hereson Road, Montefiore Avenue, Dumpton Park Drive, West Cliff Avenue and Granville Road

Bromstone Road will be closed in the vicinity of the roundabout junction with A255 Ramsgate Road; access to the remainder of Bromstone Road continues from a western (Pysons Road / Fairfield Road) direction.

Various side-roads will be closed at their junctions with A255 Ramsgate Road as the works progress, with local sign-posted diversions.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents and businesses when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
